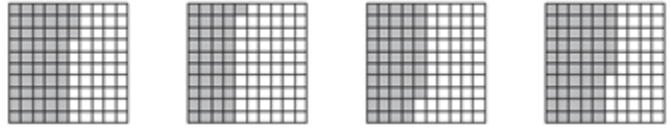
1. Jaden saves \$3.75 from his allowance each week. How much money will he save in 18 weeks?
